

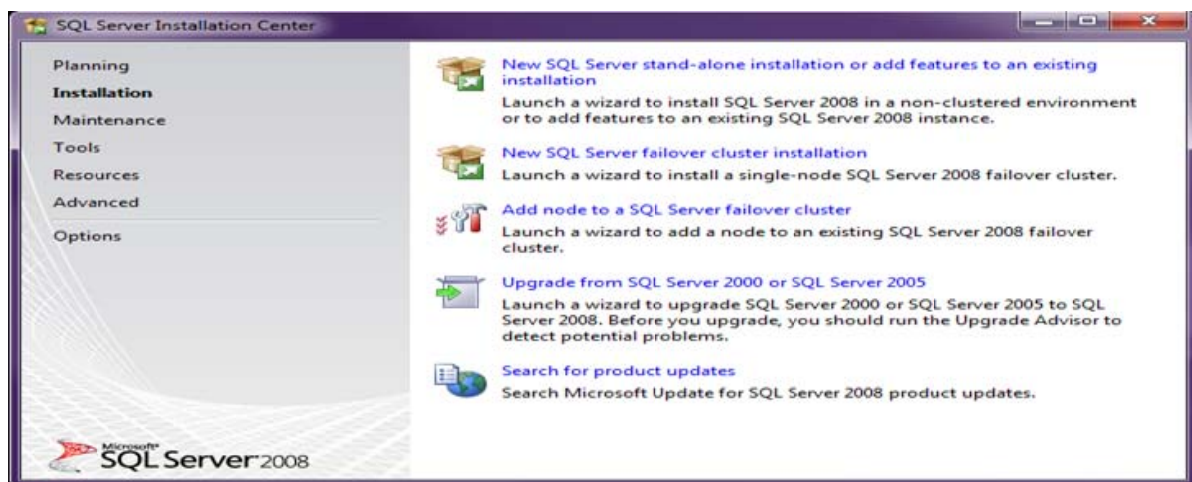
Sometimes you may need to create EMS database backup for troubleshooting purpose, or while transferring the database from one machine to another, and restore the database. The SQL server management studio is a software used for configuring, managing, and administering all components within Microsoft SQL Server and allows to to create/restore the database.

Below are the steps for installing SQL server management studio express edition.

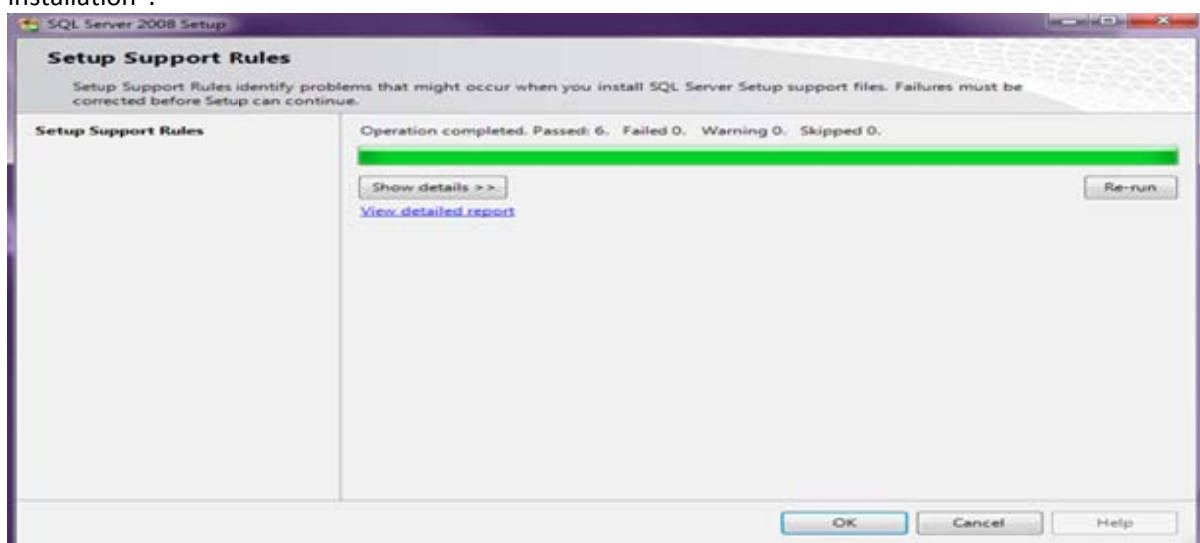
STEP 1:Download Microsoft® SQL Server 2008 Management Studio Express. Link - <http://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=7593>

STEP 2: Make sure you're logged in as an administrator.

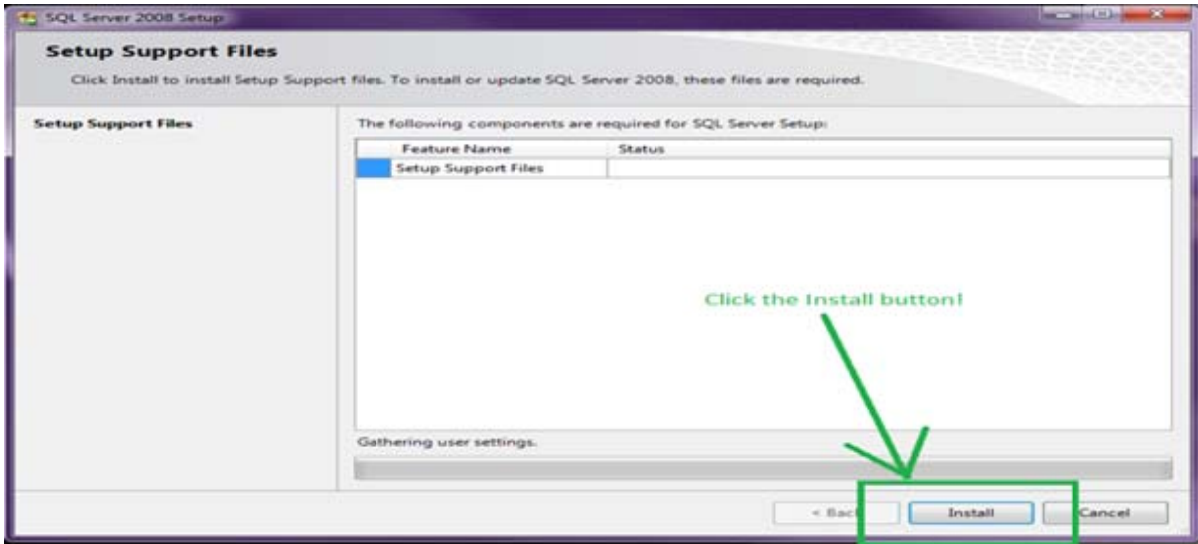
STEP 3: Run the installer; you should now see the "SQL Server Installation Center" window. Select the "Installation" tab.



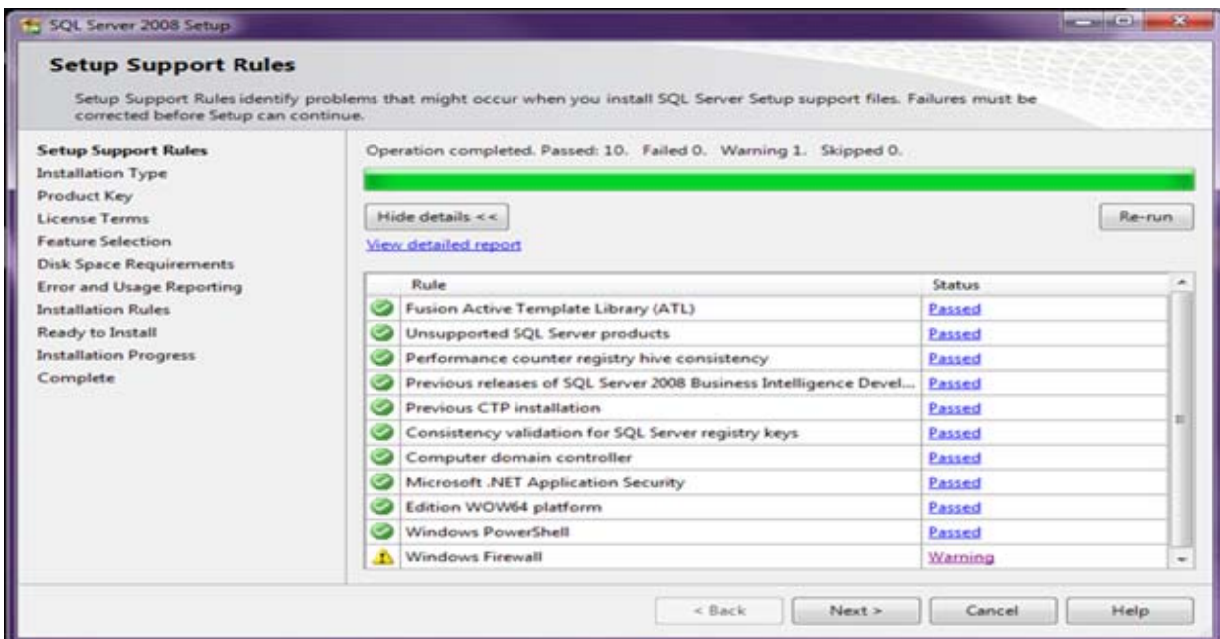
STEP 4: Select "New SQL Server stand-alone installation or add features to an existing installation".



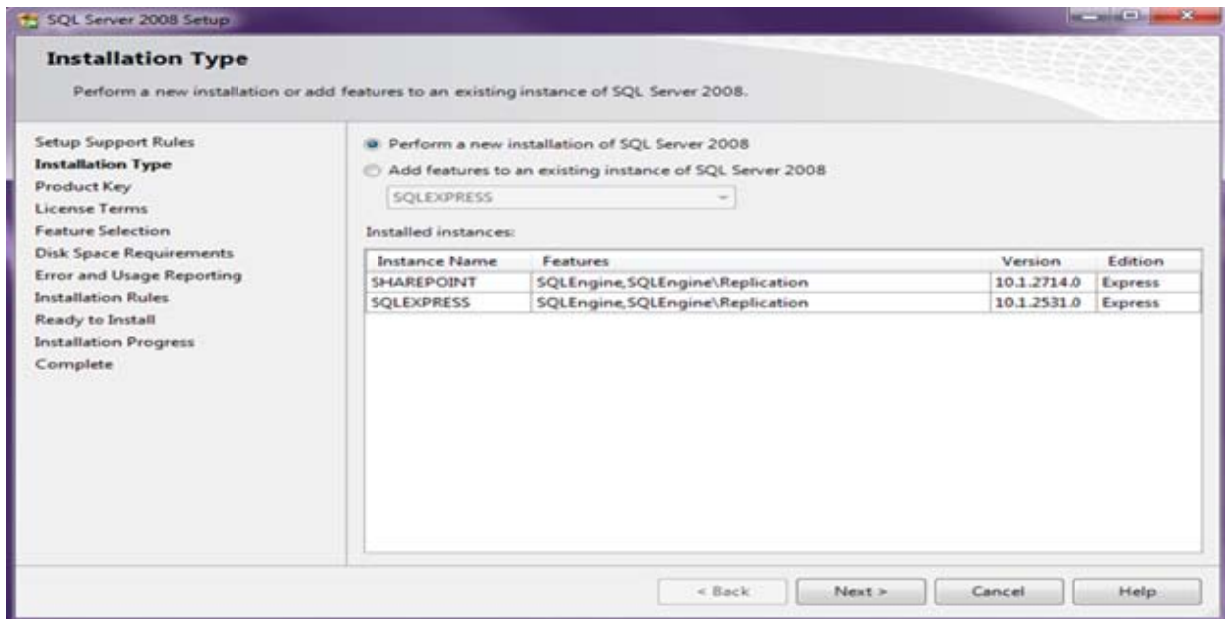
STEP 5: Install.



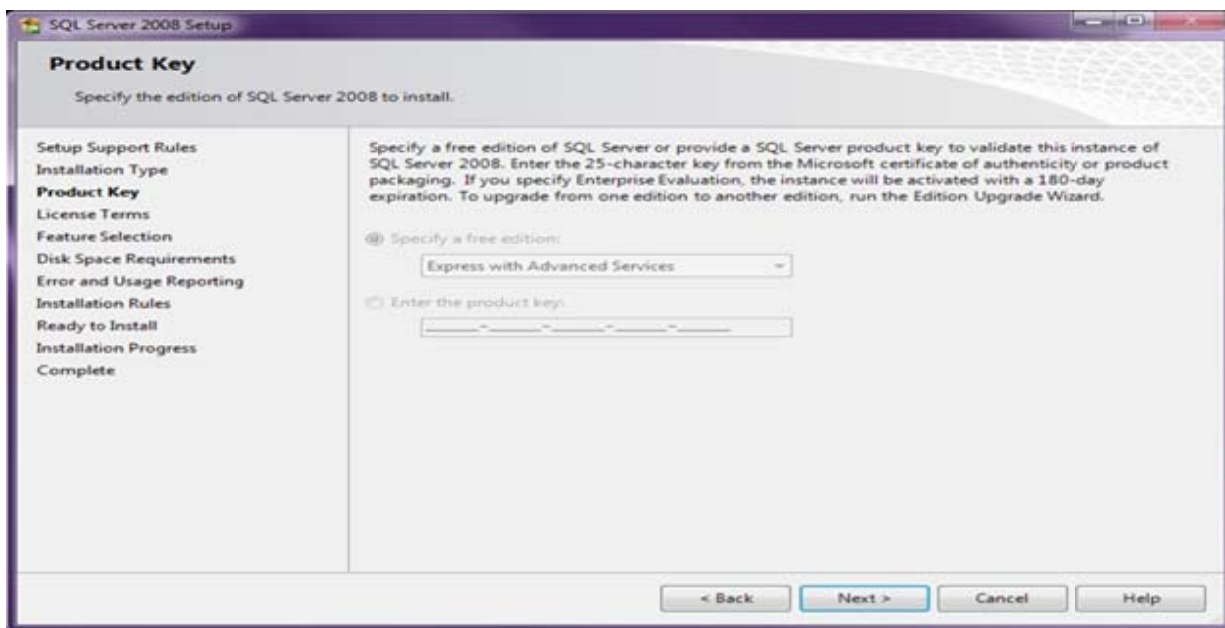
STEP 6: Next



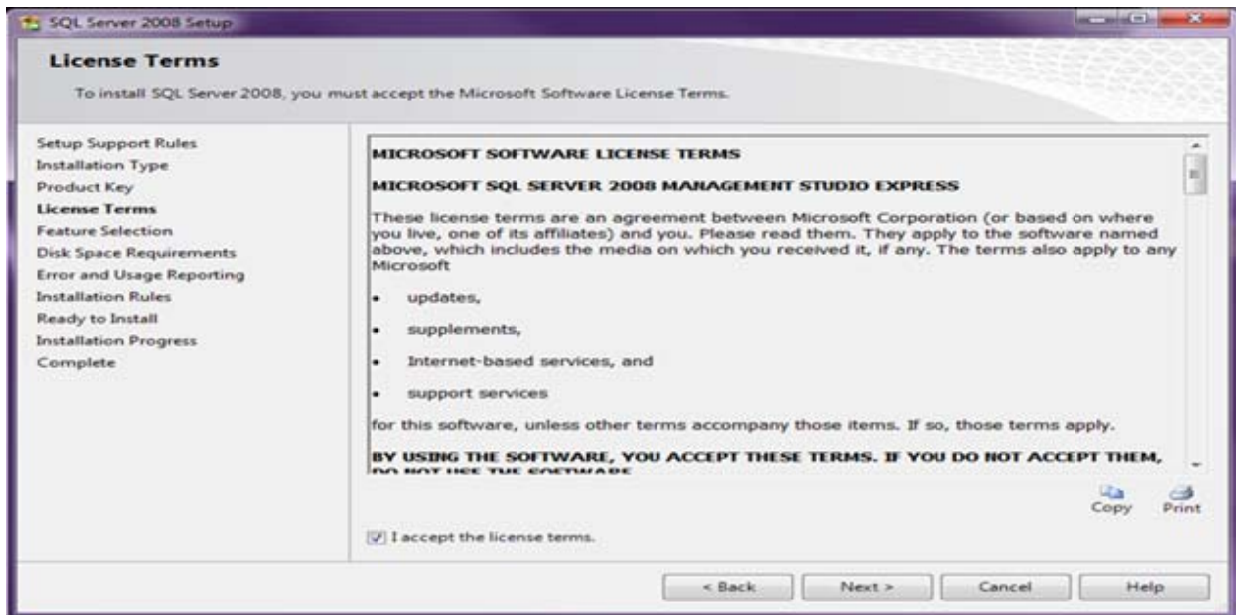
STEP 7: Select new installation-> Next



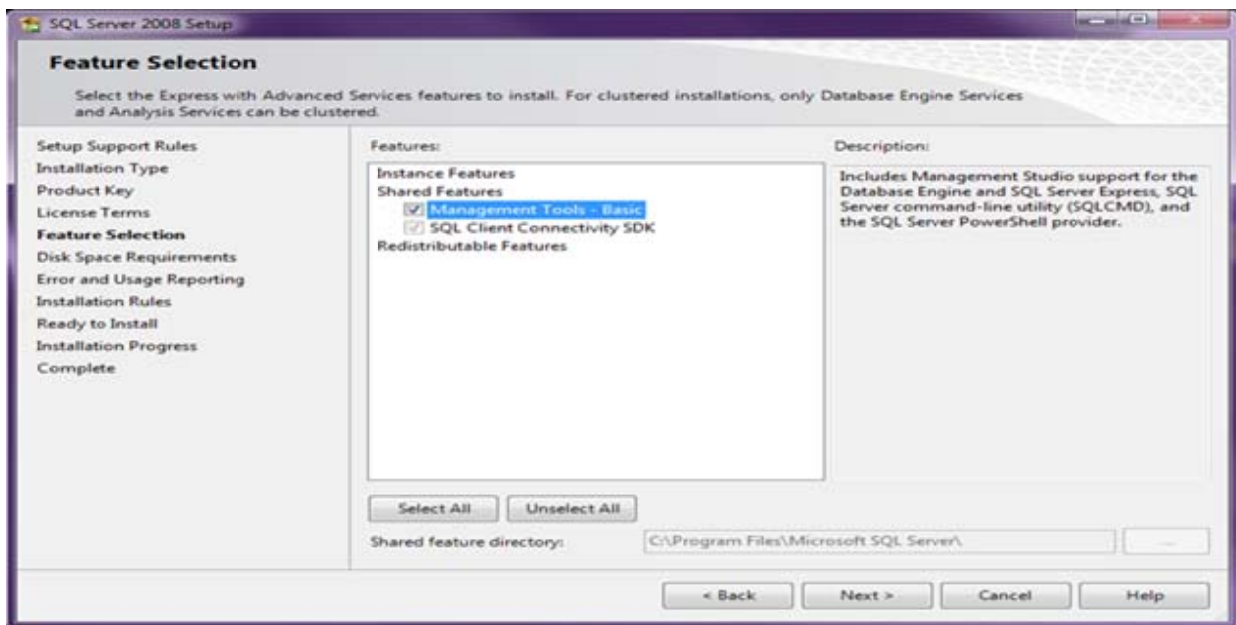
STEP 8: Next.



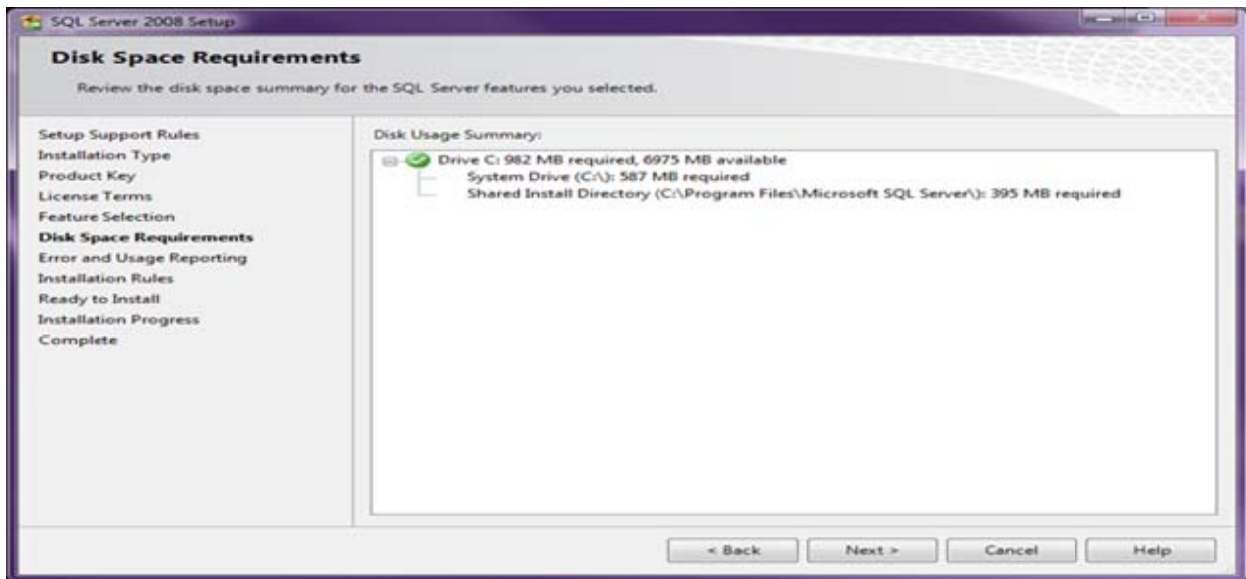
STEP 9: Accept the License Terms and click Next.



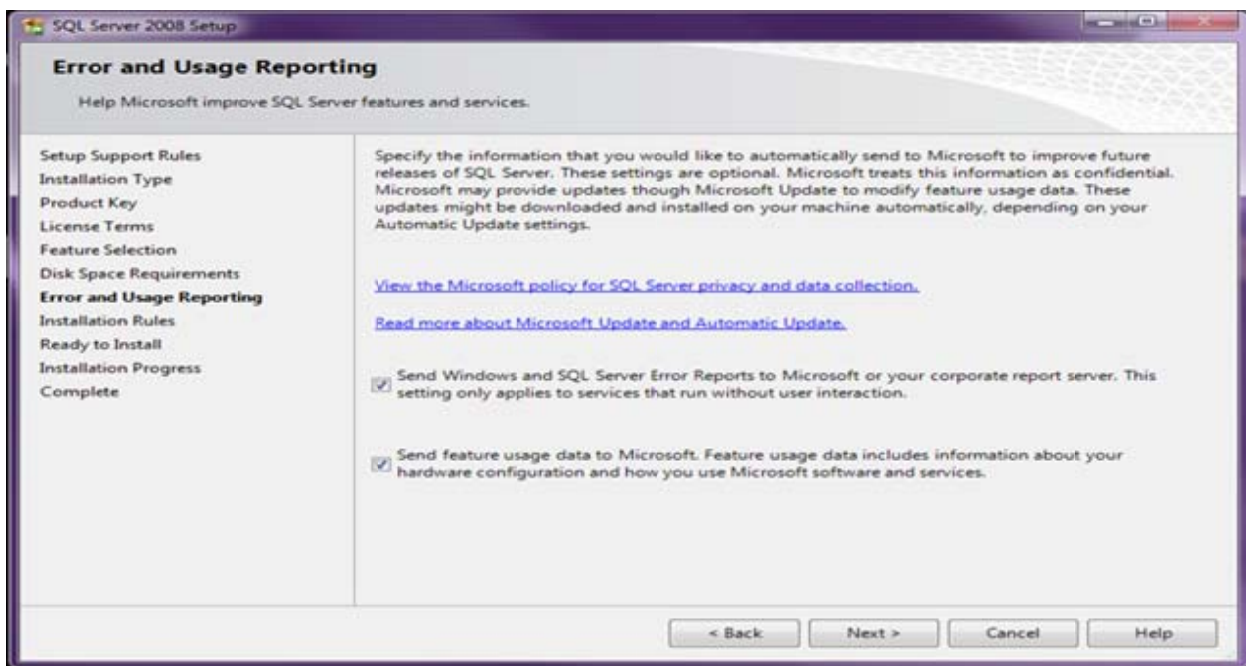
STEP 10: Check "Management Tools – Basic" and then click Next.



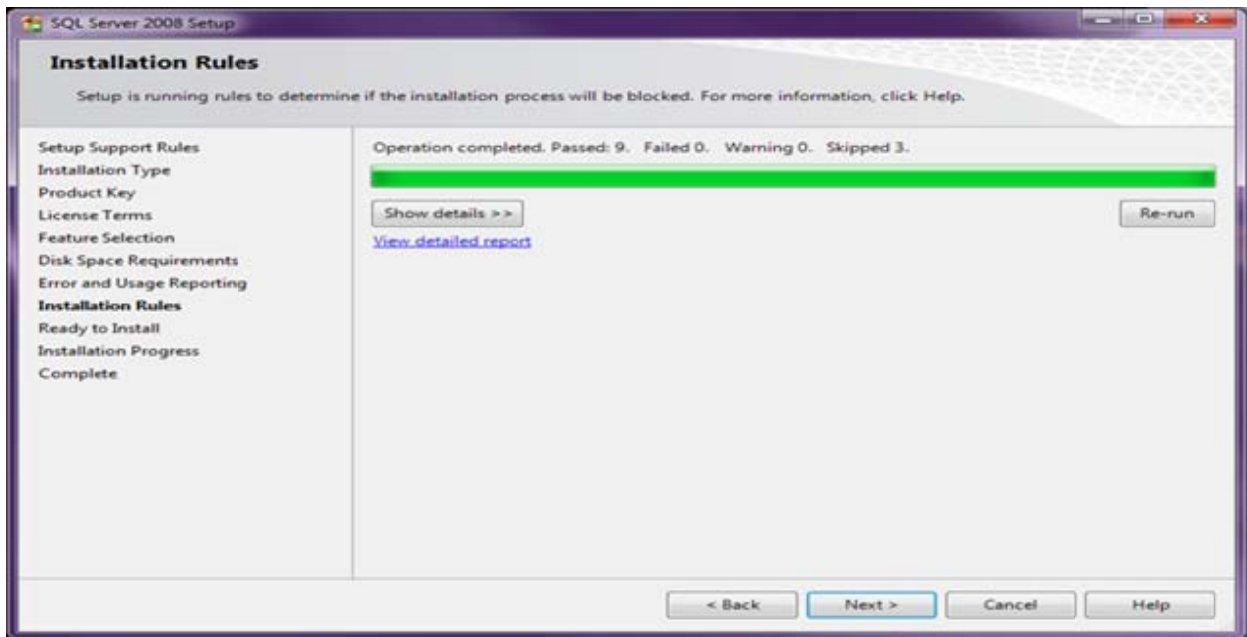
STEP 11: Verify your disk space requirements and click Next.



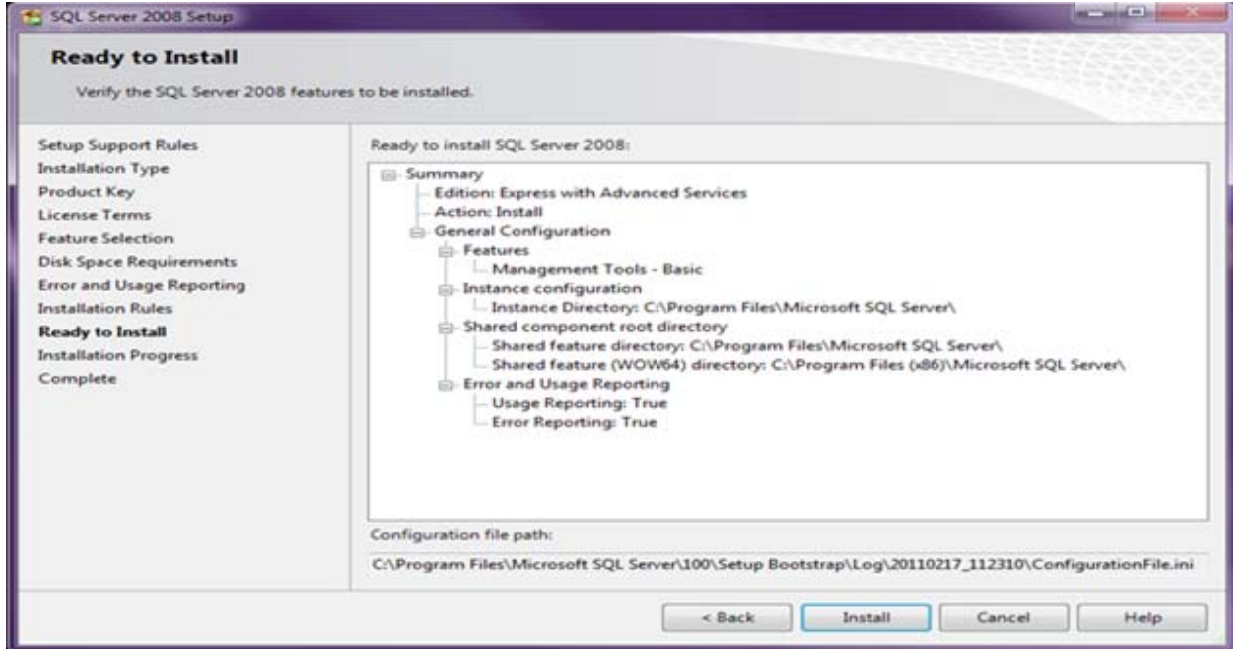
STEP 12: Help Microsoft improve SQL Server features and services by selecting to send usage and error reports to them (or not). Click Next.



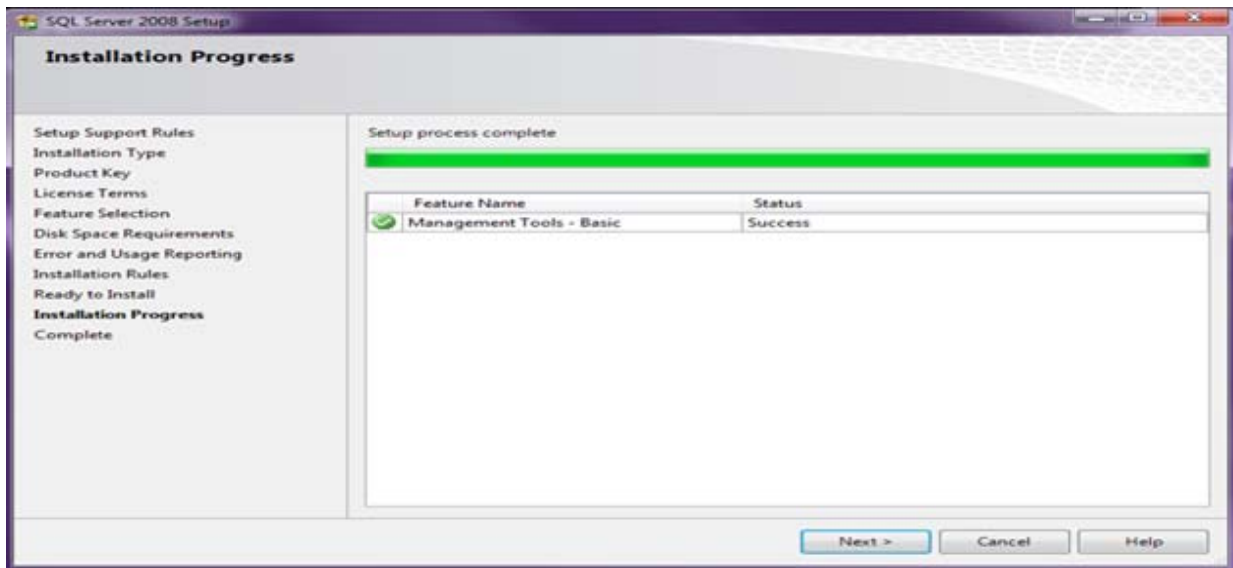
STEP 13: Next.



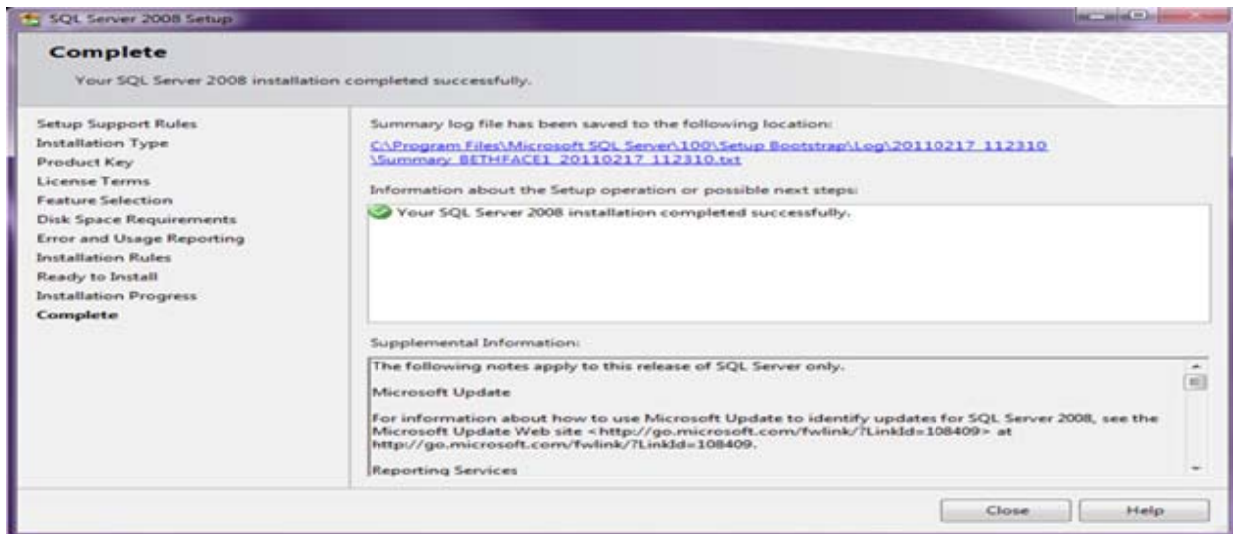
STEP 14: Install

STEP 17: Open up SQL Server Management Studio! You should now see it in your Programs under Microsoft SQL Server 2008. Make sure you run it as an administrator to access to all the features.
